... to **David Fisk and his new wife, BeCa**. They were married July 24th in Clemson and are now living in Central.

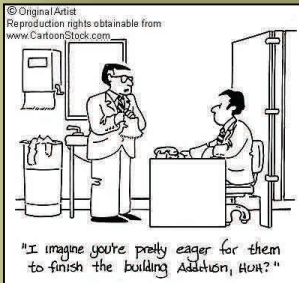

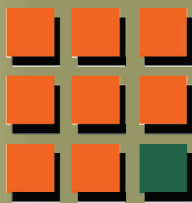

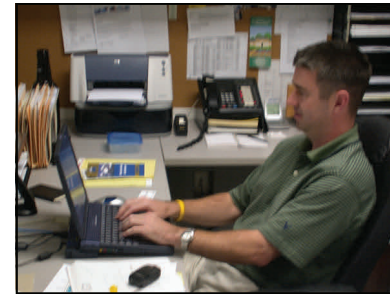
